- 2) May be enrolled in any degree-granting program.
- 3) Must be a resident of Lorain County.
- 4) Parent(s) or student must be a member of Lorain County Farm Bureau, Inc. for at least one year.
- 5) Payment for the scholarship will be made to the student after the following:
 - payment receipt for spring quarter/second semester fees (2013)
 - 2.5 GPA or higher for the first quarter/semester
 - must be continuing for the second quarter/semester
- 6) A transcript of your high school grades must be attached to the scholarship application; a 2.5 minimum grade point is required for consideration.
- 7) A signed statement of reference from a non-school individual: a minister, 4-H advisor, or other volunteer leader (not a family member) must be attached.
- 8) A scholarship committee will screen applications and may interview finalists to select the best prospective student for this scholarship. You may be called for a personal interview.
- 9) Please attach a recent photo of yourself.
